Mr. Hagan:

The Pinellas County Air Quality Division (PCAQD) is in receipt of your responses to the Notice of Violation issued on March 02, 2023.

Howco Environmental Services responded to the Notice of Violation with a written response on April 03, 2023. In this response Howco notified PCAQD they have discovered and addressed two areas of potential odors in the plant's processes:

1. The light ends recovery tank vent - This process was retrofitted with an additional engineering control of the exhaust gases, consisting of a recirculated water/deodorant misting system, added prior to venting to the atmosphere.
2. Exhaust from Air Stripper No. 2 - Residual odors are being addressed in the petroleum product and water treatment process by addition of chlorine dioxide at an earlier phase in the process.
